

# CLOTHING TIPS AND SESSION GUIDELINES

## Girls

Your hair should be styled the way you normal wear it. Your senior portrait session isn't the best time to try new hairstyle. Remember, your senior pictures are going to be hanging on your parents' living room wall for a long time. That hairstyle that is cool now..may be the subject of humor by your children twenty years from now. Just something to keep in mind. Makeup should be applied normally. Select outfits that are flattering to your figure. We highly recommend that you bring a parent or friend along, that way there is someone else to give an opinion and make sure that "nothing" is showing. We want you to feel and look your best!

## Boys

Facial hair should be neatly groomed or freshly shaved. Make sure your clothes are neatly prepared for your session. Trust us on this one. If mom doesn't like the way it looks... Guess what? You, probably will get to do it all over again!

Solid colors are traditionally best for portraits, but that doesn't mean that everything has to be a solid. If you have a favorite outfit, BRING IT! It doesn't matter what it is, provided it has parental approval and no profanity. If you like it, you will look and feel comfortable. The portraits created will be a true reflection of YOU!

## General Portrait Session Tips

- ⇒ It's always fun to bring a friend, parent, brother or sister to your session. Bringing someone along often helps you relax and enjoy the session.
- ⇒ Be comfortable with what you wear. Don't make drastic changes in hair style, clothing, or makeup just for portrait session. Haircuts should be at least two weeks old.
- ⇒ Set aside enough time for your portrait session.. Don't RUSH!
- ⇒ Get plenty of sleep the night before your session. Your portraits will always reveal if you didn't get enough Z's
- ⇒ For Extended Sessions, bring any item you would like to include in your portraits: sports equipment, cars, hobbies, awards, pets, instruments, etc.

REMEMBER OUR GOAL IS TO CREATE SENIOR IMAGES THAT SHOW THE REAL YOU! IF YOU HAVE ANY THOUGHTS OR IDEAS, PLEASE LET US KNOW! WE WANT TO CREATE IMAGES THAT REFLECT YOU!

## WHAT ARE YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES?

1. Select your session option by turning in your response card or respond on-line by **MAY 13TH**.
2. Once your session is scheduled, your next responsibility is to make sure **YOU SHOW UP ON TIME**. It is **VERY** important that **YOU SHOW UP 15 MINUTES PRIOR TO YOUR SCHEDULED TIME!!!** This allows necessary time for final sprucing up so **YOU** look your **BEST** for your senior portraits. Our time is just as important as **YOURS**; so, please be courteous and notify us as soon as you know that you will be unable to make your session. You must provide 24-hour notification in the event you are unable to make your appointment. In the event you fail to provide a 24-hour notification, you will be assessed an additional re-scheduling session charge of \$15. That means your total basic session charge will be \$30. So **SHOW UP ON TIME OR PROVIDE A 24-HOUR NOTICE TO RE-SCHEDULE!!!**
3. **YOU** are responsible for your appearance. Those wishing for make-ups for reasons of hair, make-up and clothing will be charged an additional session fee of \$15. So please put some thought into your appearance. It's important and we want you to look your **BEST!** (refer to session suggestion above to help answer any questions)
